Papers and proposals, symposiums, tutorials, case studies and workshops are invited across all business topics related to management science techniques and applications, and on innovative methods of teaching management science. Submissions by practitioners on management science applications are especially welcome.

The submission process opens on March 1, 2024, through August 1, 2024.

1. Click on the following link <https://seinform2024.exordo.com/> to make a submission to the conference. Instructions for the submission process are provided at the link. **Files must be submitted in PDF format.**
2. For 2024, SEINFORMS welcomes "Papers," "Abstracts" and "Paper Proposals" for conference attendance and presentations, as well as "Poster Presentations" for undergraduate students. Abstracts will be published in a section of the proceedings. We encourage you to come and share your research ideas with us in hopes of converting the ideas into refereed journals. "Abstracts" will not be considered for paper awards.
3. Abstracts should be a minimum of 500 words and cover at a minimum contribution and methods.
4. Paper proposals should be a minimum of four (4) pages long and describe the complete paper.
5. An author is limited to submitting a maximum of three (3) papers, either single or multiple-authored.
6. Authors and affiliations including complete addresses, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses are collected during the submission process and thus should NOT be included in the submitted document.
7. In the case of multiple authors, all correspondence will be sent to the first author, unless otherwise requested.

Participant Obligation: The submission of a paper, abstract, paper proposal, or poster for this meeting means that the author(s) agree(s) to participate in the meeting by serving as session chairs and discussants if needed. Only those authors who register to attend the meeting in advance of the publication date will have their papers published in the proceedings.

Student Papers and Posters: Graduate students are encouraged to submit papers to the appropriate subject track. Undergraduate students working with faculty sponsors are encouraged to submit posters to the Undergraduate Student Poster Session. The submission process will open on March 1, 2024, and the deadline is August 1, 2024.

Symposiums, Tutorials, and Workshops: Proposals for special sessions should include a description of the session, names and affiliations of all participants, and the proposed benefit of the session to members. It is the responsibility of the session leader to ensure that the scheduled participants attend the meeting. A one-page summary of each special session will appear in the proceedings.

SEINFORMS uses an electronic submission process.
